This scholarship celebrates the establishment of the American University of Beirut – Mediterraneo as AUB’s first twin campus in Europe. Provided to students who are nationals of and/or residing in and/or graduating from high schools or universities in the EU, EEA, or Switzerland.

Scholarships are valid for the duration of study as long as the student is in good academic standing. Scholarships (except for the President Merit Scholarship) and financial aid may be combined, but total financial assistance cannot exceed 80% of tuition.

STUDENTS WHO ARE ACCEPTED FOR EARLY ADMISSION AUTOMATICALLY RECEIVE A 30% EARLY ADMISSION MERIT SCHOLARSHIP! Those who meet the below criteria are guaranteed admission to the American University of Beirut – Mediterraneo.

Criteria: Rank in top 25% in both grades 10 and 11. Achieve at least the minimum score on one of the following exams:

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

PHILOSOPHY, POLITICS, AND ECONOMICS (PPE)

Bachelor of Arts
4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

A multidisciplinary program looking at the social, economic, and political issues and challenges facing our world in general and the eastern Mediterranean in particular, with courses in each of the disciplines and bridging the three. Includes a 4th year research project.

COMPUTER SCIENCE

Bachelor of Science
4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

Provides a solid foundation in computing at both the theoretical and practical levels, thus conferring the ability to design, build, and deploy sophisticated systems using state-of-the-art technologies in a broad array of areas.

PSYCHOLOGY

Bachelor of Science
4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

Students will explore the nature of psychological processes and functioning, gain basic knowledge and skills necessary for research in psychology, and learn about the applications of psychology in the wider community. Includes a 4th year thesis research project.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION IN MANAGEMENT

Bachelor of Business Administration
4-year program | 240 ECTS credits

Prepares students to become effective leaders in a highly competitive business world. Provides a solid foundation in all business disciplines, and is aligned with the advancements and trends in the corporate world including data analytics, innovation, and entrepreneurship.

INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING

Bachelor of Science
4-year program (with 1 summer) | 244 ECTS credits

Students learn to effectively participate in, coordinate & manage diverse teams of engineers & analysts, especially in large-scale systems. Courses include basic science, general education, business, and engineering fundamentals. Includes a 3rd year summer internship.
