The Department of Industrial Engineering and Engineering Management (IEEM) at the American University of Beirut, Mediterraneo (AUBMED) invites applications for a tenure-track position in Industrial Engineering, preferably at the rank of Assistant Professor. *The Department will also consider applicants for visiting positions in all ranks*.

The IEEM department in AUB Mediterraneo currently offers one undergraduate program in Industrial Engineering and one graduate program in Engineering Management.

Applicants from all research areas related to **Industrial/Systems Engineering** will be considered. Applicants should hold a Ph.D. degree in Industrial engineering or a closely-related field, with at least one degree in engineering by the date of appointment. Preferred research areas include but are not restricted to: Operations Research, Data Science, Human Factors Engineering, Project Management, Sustainable operations, Logistics and Supply Chain.

Candidates with teaching experience, industrial or post-doctoral appointments and a record of grant funding and scholarly publications are particularly encouraged to apply.

Brief Background about AUB-Mediterraneo and AUB

The American University of Beirut – Mediterraneo, a twin campus of the American University of Beirut in Lebanon, is approved by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education (MSCHE) as a branch campus of the American University of Beirut (AUB) in Beirut, Lebanon. AUB operates under a charter granted by the New York State Education Department (NYSED), which registers the university's degree programs and has approved AUB Mediterraneo as a twin campus of AUB.

All departments and programs at AUB Mediterraneo are accredited by the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation of Higher Education (CYQAA). The university welcomed its first cohort of students in the fall of 2023.

The American University of Beirut was founded in 1866 and bases its educational philosophy, standards, and practices on the American liberal arts model of higher education. A teaching-centered research university, it has 780 full-time faculty members and a student body of 7,800 students. AUB ranked 226 in the 2024 Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings (WUR), solidifying the university's status as a top-tier educational institution regionally and globally. The university currently offers more than 120 programs leading to bachelor's, master's, MD, and PhD degrees. It provides medical education and training to students from throughout the region at its medical center, that includes a full-service 365-bed hospital).
